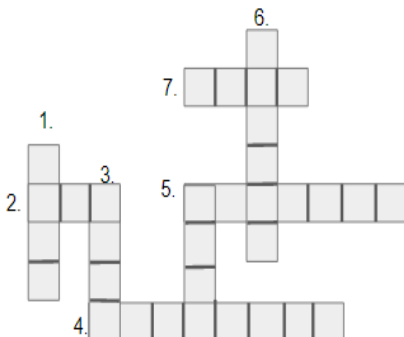

Q: What is your job and why do you like most about it?

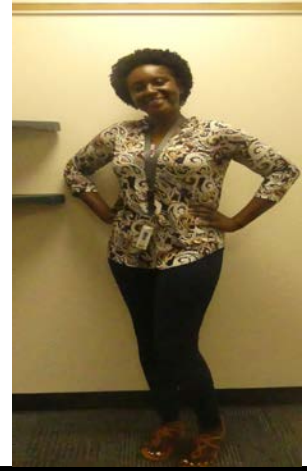
A: I am a guidance counselor and I love teaching people about mental health and I love working with Kids.
