The Mantis Shrimp



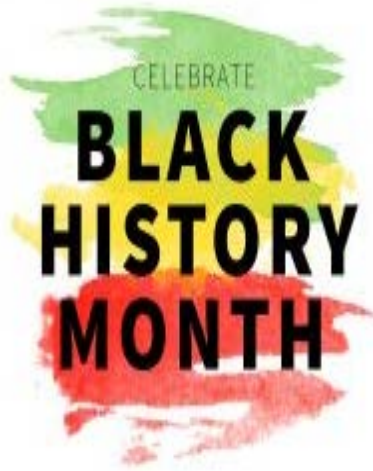

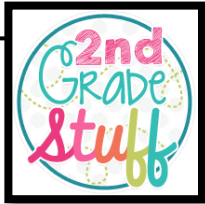

5th grade ELA classes will be working on their Modern Woodsmen Speech.

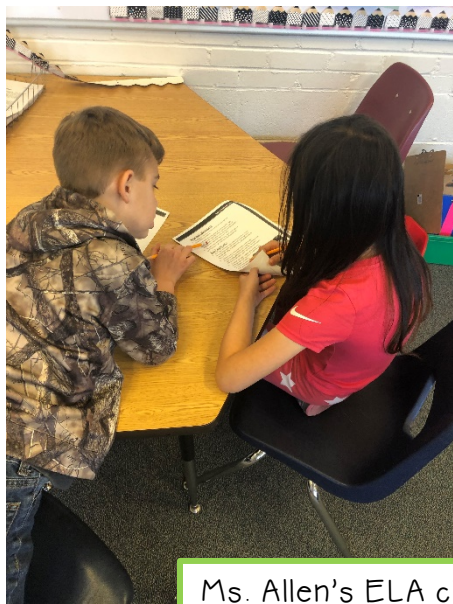
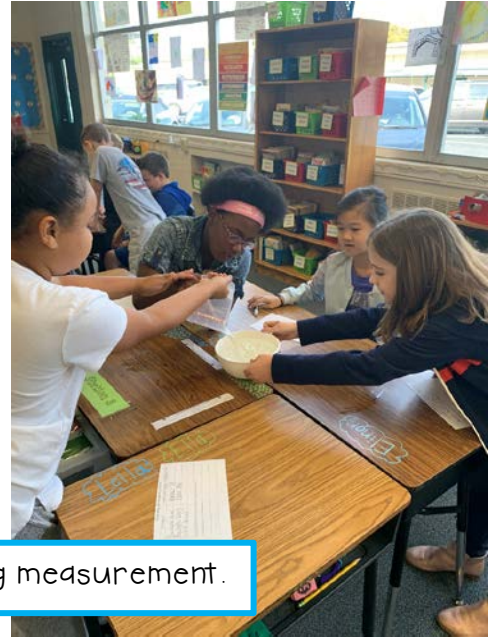

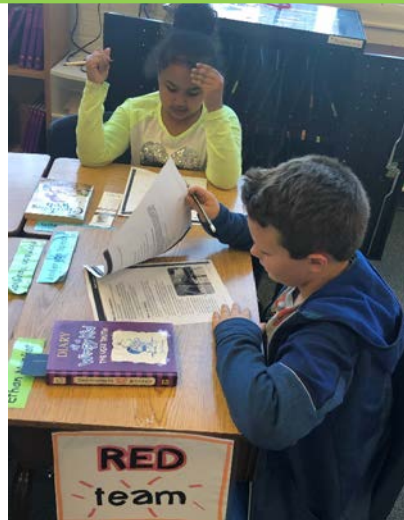

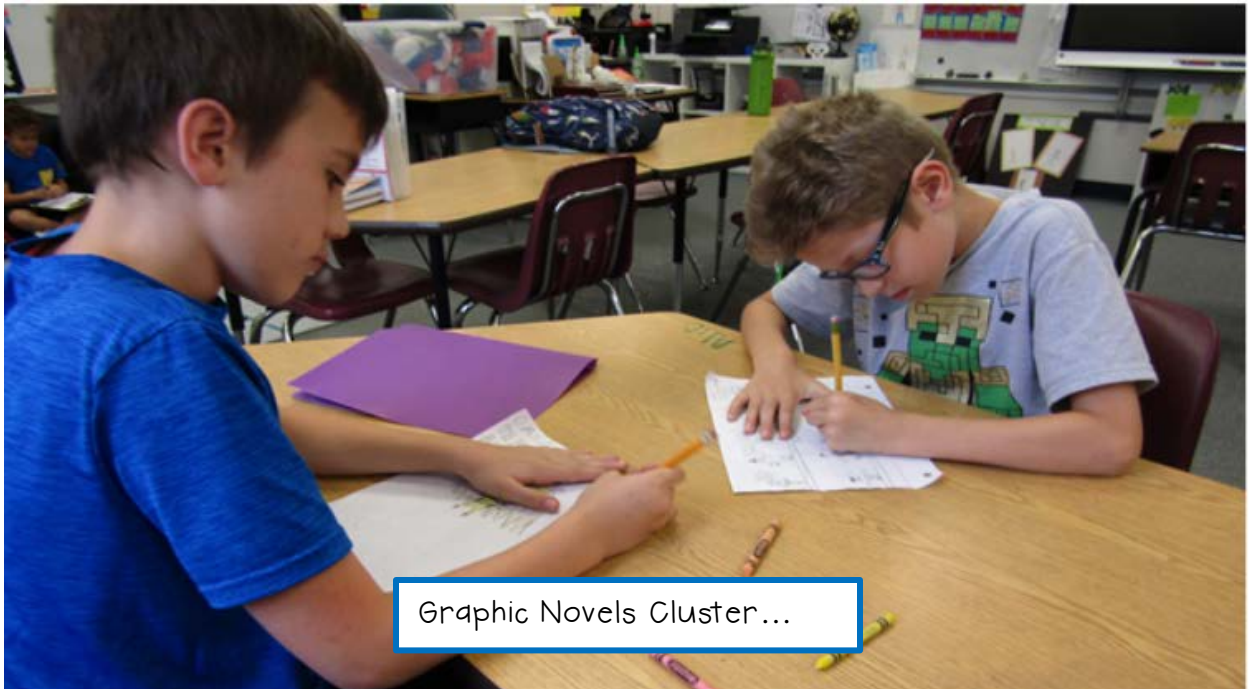
