

The Best Fireworks For Celebrating This Summer

This summer there are plenty of reasons to celebrate. Memorial Day, Fourth of July and so on. What better way to celebrate than light off some fireworks?(With a permit if need be, don't want to go to jail this summer do we?) The question that often springs to mind when considering buying fireworks is, what are the best ones to buy?

Whether you prefer fireworks that fly up into the sky or the ones that light up the ground, there are plenty of options to choose from. The prices are not always the greatest depending on where they are purchased from or what type of firework it is, however sometimes it is absolutely worth it. Even if lighting off fireworks is not your forte or an option for you, hopefully this list of the five best fireworks will still be helpful.

1. The Fiery Frogs Fountain

This firework just happens to be one of the best sellers from Phantom Fireworks, well all of these are, but I can speak from personal experience when I say that this may just be the best one. This particular firework sells for \$25 and has a pretty cool effect. What you do is put this firework on the ground, light the fuse, step away, and once that is done, it pops into colorful sparks that fall all over the surrounding ground. It is quite mesmerizing if I do say so myself.

2. Red, White, and Boom!, 16 Shot

As previously stated, this firework is also a best seller from Phantom Fireworks. I have no experience with this one in particular, however, it still seems to be pretty cool based off of the little bit that I have seen. This firework is a little bit cheaper, selling for \$18, but in my opinion, that is a wonderful deal for what it does. Red, White and Boom is one of those fireworks that flies into the sky from the box it is in once the fuse is lit.Once this happens, the sky is lit up with a trio of colors consisting of red, blue, and silver. It can go up as high as 125 feet and as you can see in the name, has a total of 16 shots.

3. Emerald City, 16 Shot

As I'm sure you've guessed, Emerald City is also a Phantom Fireworks best seller. This firework is somewhat similar to Red, White and Boom for a couple reasons. They both fly into the air, they both have a total of 16 shots as stated in their name and they both sell for \$18. There are some differences though. Emerald City lights up green and gold as opposed to red, blue, and silver. Emerald City does also have some cool effects. When it is up in the sky, it takes the shape of rings and has a very powerful glitter effect as well.

4. Peacock Tail Fountain

The Peacock Tail Fountain is another non-aerial firework similar to Fiery Frogs Fountain. Peacock Tail Fountain is a little more expensive, selling for \$40, but it seems to be worth it. How this one works is you put it on the ground, light the fuse, and step a safe distance away. What happens is it erupts into red, blue, green, and white stars and flowers that fly far and high into the distance. This goes on for a good minute until as a grand finale, it erupts into white sparks with a loud crackle.

5. Fierce Tiger Soaring Rockets

This final firework is for those of us either on a budget or who just want something a little more low-key that won't get the neighbors to hate them. The Fierce Tiger Soaring Rockets is an aerial firework that comes with 12 rockets and sells for \$10. How they work is the person lighting them off puts the stick into the ground, lights the fuse, and steps away. Once they do this, it will fly into the air with an orange comet tail and a color burst as the ending.
