Call to Order:

A meeting of the Orlando Gifted Academy School Advisory Council was held in the auditorium on January 27, 2022. Chair Melonie Sexton called the meeting to order at 5:31p. Ericka Scheid will record minutes for this meeting.

Approval of Previous Minutes:

December 2021 minutes: Sarah Courtney motions to approve December minutes. Martina Herndon seconds. Minutes are approved.

New Business:

Principal's Report (Announcements/HR & Budget Updates): Mid-Year Review of SIP Goals: Instruction (Differentiation) – Use of iReady and PMA data; Using MOY data for elementary and PMA for middle school; Activities to support math: Math fluency competitions – classes win trophy for the week; Math Blast after school tutoring started week of 1/24 – will be held on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Saturdays; Girls Math Competition with Orlando Math Circle; Math Counts this past weekend; Teachers will continue tutoring and small group instruction; Administration and Leadership Team will continue with classroom walkthroughs; Tier 1 Intervention teacher provides push in and pull out assistance for students; Social Emotional Caring School Community implemented in all elementary classrooms; The CSC kits provide lessons and books to support social emotional learning in the classroom; Some middle school teachers will begin using CSC in their classrooms; Character Lab is a program for our middle schoolers to utilize to support their social emotional development; 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens for every middle school student (students are using this book during Advanced Academics class); 7 Habits of Highly Effective Kids in the elementary classrooms; Ms Courtney asked if there was a way to collect data on use of CSC in the elementary school classrooms to celebrate how it's going; Ms. Despenza stated we will work on creating a survey to gauge teacher perception on the effects they have seen with students since implementing; Ms. Gal asked where the School Improvement Plan can be located – Can be found on the OCPS Accountability & Improvement website; Ms. Gal asked if this year's SAC will provide recommendations for next year's SIP – yes; Ms. Despenza shared she doesn't receive data for SIP until late in summer; She also shared how last year's SAC recommended more concentrated effort on differentiated learning, which resulted in purchase of Renzulli Learning; She also shared about a recent training middle school teachers attended (Defined Learning);

<u>Field Trips</u>: On hold; Competitions are permissible; Starbase for 5th grade (@Research Park with Department of Defense & UCF) – students who attend Starbase in 5th grade will be able to attend the middle school camp at no charge;

<u>Clubs</u>: Dr. Sexton contacted community members to see if they would be interested in sharing resources regarding after school club; She is willing to do Neuroscience, a colleague is able to do Dead Language, another colleague could do virtual workshops on Anthropology (Dr. Sexton will share information on how to access resources).; Ms. Courtney asked about clubs – no new clubs will be starting;
