Open Agenda (Non-SAC Members): Topics of Concern

Q: Question on personnel/hiring for teacher role- what was process for hiring? Open applications or through district?

A: Regular application and interview and references from current principal. Started hiring process earlier because this was a new school. Will be in a better position next year since we know the children better. Just a growing pain of new school.

Q: We have great gifted teachers but they seem to not know about disabilities/ uniquiness/disabilities/sensory processing issue. Is there training forthcoming for these teachers? A: Training is offered for teachers; They may have endorsement but may have not been in setting where they have taught gifted kids all day. Will have more training based on needs identified in the students. Encourage parents to share in parent/teacher conference Teacher says it is easier when parents are forward and give information up front about their child so the teacher is aware and can prepare/tailor their approach for that student. Q: For the applicants that applied, were they considered if they were working towards

endorsement or was it a requirement to have it?

A: Following district guidelines, as long as they have started the process for gifted endorsement, they can teach gifted children. 80% of the teachers are fully gifted endorsed.

Q: Will there be any way to look at the class sizes to make them smaller since teachers have so much to do as the general education teacher and gifted teacher all in one?

A: The schools budget dictates how many teachers that can be hired. Maybe next year we can look at the budget and the class sizes and make that determination.

Q: Will there be a 6th grade addition to OGA next year? As a parent of a current OGA 5th grader who is thriving, there is concern about this.

A: Principal Knowles is working with the district on this and encourages parents to write the district superintendent and voice your concerns and share you success stories of OGA so far. His contact information is Rahim.Jones@ocps.net.
